

***SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL AMENDED MINUTES
COUNCIL CHAMBERS
JANUARY 26, 2022
5:30 p.m.***

The council met in special session. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hull. On roll call, the following members answered present: Bill Talbott, Judd Chestnut, Mark Gardner, John Gilkey, Brian Griffith, Mike Main, Logan Powell, and Tim Riegel.

Also attending, Russ Worsley – City Administrator, Rusty Rives – Assistant City Administrator, Sandra Phipps – Deputy City Clerk, Steven Kaderly- City Attorney.

Russ Worsley read a highlighted summary of Water’s Edge Report on the Aquatic Park. A discussion followed. After discussion, Alderman Gilkey made the motion close the Aquatic Park effective March 1,2022. Alderman Gardner seconded the motion. On vote, all members voted yes.

Administrator Worsley then said he had secured a quote of \$113,100.00 for a backup generator for the well and lift station at the water plant. He stated that the current generator was not big enough to power everything. It is a necessity to be able to pump water from the well if power goes out.

Alderman Chestnut made the motion to approve the purchase of the generator. Alderman Riegel seconded the motion. On vote, all members voted yes.

Mayor Hull asked if there was any more business to come before the council, if not, a motion to adjourn would be in order. Alderman Griffith made the motion to adjourn. Alderman Main seconded the motion. On vote, all members voted yes. Therefore, the meeting was adjourned at 6:43 p.m.
